

THE TOTTINGTON LOWER END TITHE MAP, 1842

This map was surveyed in 1842 (or just before) to allow the calculation of tithe payments to the established church. Only three copies were ever made - one is now at Bury Library, one at the Lancashire Record Office (Preston) and one at the Public Record Office (London).

The map was accompanied by a very detailed *schedule* which gives the following information for each plot number:

Landowner's name

Occupier's name

Name and description of the plot (ie field name, or type of building)

State of cultivation


Area


Rent charge
